# Recruitment Guide

# 1. Qualification Requirements

- 1) Those who have completed at least 12 years of regular education in their home country.
- 2) Must have studied Japanese at least 150 hours at a Japanese language education facility.
- 3) Must be J-Test Level F or higher or at the same level on the Japanese Language Proficiency Test N5 or higher.

# 2. Recruitment Period

April admission: Until November 20 of the previous year

July admission: Until February 20

October admission: Until May 20

January admission: Until August 20 of the previous year

# 3 Class Time

Monday to Friday, 4 hours a day, 20 hours per week

(1 frame = 45 minutes)

Morning class - 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Afternoon class - 13:30p.m. -17:00p.m.

## 4. School guide and contents

**Beginner's Course**: For beginners in Japanese, students acquire basic Japanese skills.

Students will be able to read and write simple sentences and conversations useful for daily life, and aim to acquire general conversational skills in Japanese and basic skills necessary for understanding sentences.

◆ Learning content: Basic sentence patterns, vocabulary, listening comprehension, pronunciation / daily conversation expression, simple sentence writing

Intermediate course: For those who have completed their elementary level of Japanese language.

Students develop the ability to talk, read, and write about general matters

◆ Learning contents: Sentence patterns necessary for more diverse expressions, listening comprehension necessary for vocabulary / natural conversation, natural conversation expressions including pronunciation / treatment expressions

Advanced Course: For intermediate Japanese finishers, Acquire more advanced and comprehensive Japanese language skills.

We will enhance the ability to operate Japanese by incorporating a variety of teaching materials such as newspapers, television, videos, magazines, literary works, etc. We aim to go on to a Japanese university, graduate school, vocational school, study there, and learn Japanese necessary for life. Students will develop the comprehensive Japanese language skills necessary for social life.

Note: Advanced courses include advanced A and B classes, and advanced B requires higher academic ability required to enter difficult universities and graduate schools.

◆Contents of study: Essays based on advanced sentence patterns, vocabulary / conversation expression themes necessary for social life / Ability examinations, EJU preparation / Literary works / Japanese affairs / Group discussions / Elective subjects

JLPT and University Entrance Examination Preparation Course Period: 1st Term (2nd to 6th Term), 2nd Term (July-November)

We regularly conduct mock examinations for EJU.

Ability trial vs. measures Giving and intensifying work

Preparation classes — June to July, October to December (until the end of the ability test) Practice and practice exams to develop practical skills,

Reinforcement classes - After school during preparation classes, solve past exam questions and further improve your practical skills.

Expenses to be paid after entering Japan

1. Health checkup 7,000 yen (annual), other bicycle insurance 2,000 yen (annual).

## About school payment

- 1. After the Certificate of Eligibility has been issued, please pay the school payment by the specified date.
- 2. The remaining school payment must be paid one year after enrollment, each semester (the due date will be announced at a later date).
- 3. If the school payment is not paid by the due date, you may receive a "withdrawal recommendation".
- 4. If your visa application is denied after the issuance of the Certificate of Eligibility, we will refund the school payment in full. The 30,000 yen selection fee will not be refunded in any case.

In addition, in the case of refusal to enroll due to personal circumstances after payment of school payment, an application administrative fee of 100,000 yen will be collected and the remaining amount will be refunded to the payer himself/herself.

5. After confirming the payment of the school payment, we will send you a Certificate of Eligibility. \*All remittances must be transferred to a bank account designated by AKK Bunka Institute.
